Daily commercial air service from Montreal to both Inuit communities provides our guests with comfortable, reliable and efficient travel North. Float planes and Twin Engine Otters await to take you on the last leg of your journey, to your *selected* hunting camp.

Outfitting Quebec - Labrador Caribou hunts requires careful planning and attention to detail. Arctic Adventures' hunts are organized to provide our hunters with a memorable experience on the tundra. When you book a hunt with us, *you know where you will be hunting with a maximum of eight hunters in camp.* You can expect to relax and enjoy five full days of exciting caribou hunting, trout fishing and northern adventure. Our chartered Single Otter enables us to move hunters if caribou migrations shift. Due to the superb locations of our hunting camps, *our success rate for two mature bulls has been close to 100% over the past ten years.* All our camps are warm, clean and comfortable with shower facilities, generated electricity and satellite telephone service.

*Based on our 30 plus years of outfitting experience, we have developed two types of hunts which satisfy the needs of our hunting guests.*

Our **Guided Caribou hunts** are intended for those hunters who want to hunt and fish with a one guide per two hunter ratio. Each day afield two hunters are accompanied by an experienced Inuit guide who is knowledgeable of the hunting territory and the migratory paths the caribou prefer. Each guide has his own freighter canoe and motor enabling hunters to travel, fish and hunt at their own pace. Guides are responsible for all game handling and transportation back to camp. Camp staff take care of caping, storing and packaging your game for homebound transportation. This hunt offers the opportunity to tag two caribou, wing shoot for ptarmigan and trout fish while enjoying friendly Inuit hospitality.

Our **Semi Guided Caribou hunts** are intended for those hunters who wish to experience a more hands-on hunt with a one guide per four hunter ratio. Each day afield four hunters are accompanied by an experienced guide who organizes the day's hunt for his group. Each guide has his own freighter canoe and motor which is very useful for travel to hunting areas and fishing hot spots. A hunter who books a Semi Guided hunt should be able to field dress his caribou and help his guide pack his game off the land. Guides assist with caping and assure that all game is identified and stored in a screened meat house. Before departing camp, hunters are required to pack their game and wrap their antlers for homebound transportation. Meat boxes and antler wrapping materials are provided at camp. Guides work with their hunters to make sure all packing is done smoothly and properly.



All camps operated by Arctic Adventures provide hunters with solid oil heated sleeping accommodations and tasty meals prepared by a camp cook. Facilities include hot showers, generated electricity and satellite telephone communications. Each camp has a screened meat house and all materials necessary to pack game for homebound transportation. Each camp manager has small game, black bear and fishing permits for hunters who want to hunt ptarmigan, black bear or fish for trout. Our camps are organized for our hunters' comfort and satisfaction.

*Our quality hunting packages are complete with no hidden costs.*

Arctic Adventures' hunt packages include:

- Air transportation from Montreal to Kuujjuaq or Puvirnitug
- Air transportation from Kuujjuaq or Puvirnitug to camp
- Shuttles to and from airports
- Co-ordination services in Kuujjuaq or Puvirnitug and home bound in Montreal
- Two nights hotel accommodations in Montreal based on double occupancy
- Six nights accommodations at all Kuujjuaq camps
- Seven nights accommodations at Tuksukatuk Lodge
- Tasty home cooked meals prepared by camp cook
- Bedding
- Hot showers
- Five days hunting at all Kuujjuaq camps
- Six days hunting at Tuksukatuk Lodge
- One guide, freighter canoe and motor per two hunters or per four hunters
- Hunting license valid for two caribou
- Topographic map of hunting area
- Fishing for Lake Trout and Native Brook Trout
- Hunting in season for Black Bear and Willow Ptarmigan
- Screened storage facilities for preservation of your game
- One shoulder mount cape skinned by camp staff
- Meat boxes for transportation of game
- Preparation of antlers and packaging of game for home bound transportation
- Transportation of 200 lb (90 kg) of meat and two sets of split antlers to Montreal
- Refrigerated storage for game in Montreal
- Satellite telephone communications
- All Federal, Provincial, and airport taxes.
- **Important:** Arctic Adventures will, weather and the presence of caribou permitting, move you to a more productive area at no extra cost.

Hunt packages do not include:

- Sleeping bag in Semi Guided Camps
- Hunting and fishing licenses other than caribou hunting license
- Hunting and fishing equipment
- Transportation of your meat and antlers from Montreal to your final destination
- Meals in Montreal, insurance, items of a personal nature
- Any costs other than those specified in hunt packages described above.

## Booking Conditions Rates

Round trip air transportation, taxes and hunting permit costs included in your all inclusive hunting package are effective at time of printing. Any increase will be added to the cost of the trip.

### Reservations

A 30% deposit is required within 10 days of your booking. Hunting trip final payment is due on July 1st, 2006.

### Cancellation Policy

A reservation with deposit is accepted under the condition that the final payment will be paid by July 1st, 2006. Trips not fully paid by this date will be considered as being cancelled by the client and the following fees will apply:

- Up to July 1st, 2006 .....30% of the published rate
- Between July 1st 2006 and date of departure .....100% of the published rate

Only written cancellations will be accepted. Cancellation insurance is advisable and can be obtained from our office.

### Legal Claims

All contracts entered into with Arctic Adventures are deemed to have originated in the Province of Quebec, Canada. Any litigation that may result must be addressed to the appropriate Quebec court.

## Liability

Arctic Adventures and/or its agents do not assume responsibility nor shall be liable for any injury, damage or loss of any nature whatsoever, caused or occasioned by neglect, default or by any act of commission and/or omission, whether negligent or not, of any person, company or carrier, nor of their respective representatives, servants and/or employees.

Flight delays may be encountered due to reasons beyond our control. In the event of an uncontrollable delay, we cannot be held responsible for shortened holiday time, missed connections, extra expenses for food and lodging or other loss or damages which may result. If your arrival at the camp is delayed due to uncontrollable circumstances, the full rate will apply. If you are delayed in leaving the camp, there will be no extra charge.

In the event it becomes necessary or advisable for the comfort or the well-being of our guests or for any reason whatever to terminate, amend and/or cancel confirmed reservations for any period, or portions thereof, due to strikes, national emergencies, weather or similar situations normally referred to as acts of God, or any situation which is believed to be in the best interest of the guests of Arctic Adventures, such action will be taken without penalty to Arctic Adventures, companies, corporations or persons participating in this operation. Should illness, safety or personal reasons necessitate the evacuation of one or more guests, the evacuation expenses will be paid by the guest(s) involved.

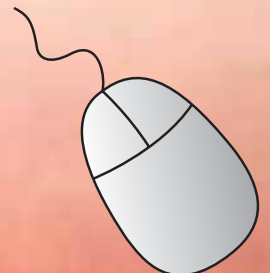

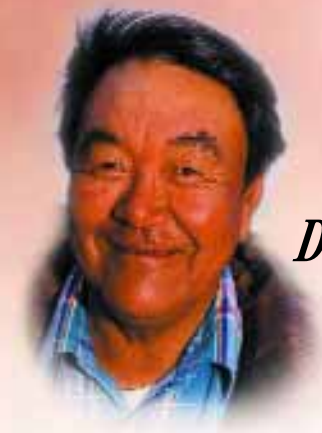
